Jurassic Home-Learning Activities

Please use the following list of activities to support you with home-learning. You will find your logins for the online activities in your reading diary.

- **Manga High** – work through the assigned activities and use the games/additional activities to support any areas of maths which you are less confident in.
- **Spelling Shed** – practise words assigned (you may have Read, Write, Inc. word lists as well the year 5/6 statutory word list)
- **Times Tables Rock Stars** – become a rock legend! Practise your times tables and keep increasing your speed!
- **NumBots** - you can access this using your TT Rock Stars log on to practise addition, subtraction and number bonds.
- **BBC Dance Mat typing** – Can you learn to touch type?

- Continue to work through your **CPG reading comprehension** and **maths revision guides**.
- **Y6** - Use BBC bite size to revise, practise and test yourself on areas you are unsure of (this is particularly useful for maths and SPaG). You could use your previous SATs practise papers to identify areas to focus on.
- **Book study** - using the book(s) you are currently reading (either library or books from home), complete at least 2 or all of following activities:

Write a review of the book you are reading.	Write a 'hidden chapter' of the book, or an alternate ending.	Write a diary entry from the point of view of the main character, detailing an event from your book.
Choose a character from the book and write their biography, using evidence from the book to help you.	Choose a setting from your book and write a short description of it. You could also draw it!	What might have happened before the first chapter of your book? What might happen next? Write a prequel or sequel!
